## Example event history of a female Scottish Longitudinal Study (SLS) member born January 1991

This diagram is a timeline showing an example event history of a female SLS member. It shows that:

- she entered SLS in the 1991 Census aged three months.
- she emigrated from Scotland to England and a few years later returned to Scotland.
- she was traced at the 2001 Census.
- between 2007 and 2010 education data including qualifications was linked.
- she was traced at the 2011 Census
- subsequent marriage and birth of child registrations were also linked.

It can also be seen that over her life course health data from the NHS can also be linked. This includes information on child health, hospital admissions, cancer registration and maternity data. This data is not held as part of SLS but can be linked on a project by project basis.
